Adjudicator Profile: Lenore Bullock



Lenore studied Ballet, Jazz and Character from age 7. She passed all her Royal Academy of Dance Examinations to Advanced Levels. In 1978 she was awarded her provisional teaching certificate through Royal Academy of Dance (London), and in 1980 received her full teaching registration. She spent time on cruise ships (Sitmar lines and P&O) teaching and performing. And since 1978 has successfully sat over 2,000 children for RAD ballet exams. She was accepted as a registered teacher with Theatrical Dance International, and has sat many students through this syllabus as well.

Lenore's past students have gone on to dance with the Australian Ballet School, the Australian Ballet Company, Les Ballet de Monte Carlo, Nederlands Dance Theatre, Queensland Ballet Company and more. Her students have gained employment on Cruise lines, dancing in Korea, Japan, France and at Disneyland in Tokyo, Los Angeles, and Hong Kong. Many students competed very successfully at Eisteddfods throughout Australia, and are now teachers themselves around the world. Lenore has adjudicated throughout Australia and NZ.

She has been teaching Dance to young people for almost 40 years, and now operates Studio 246 in Auckland, a school with over 800 students. She is very passionate about teaching and sharing her knowledge. Lenore cannot wait to see the talented dancers from Southland!!

Adjudicator Profile: Melanie Bullock



Melanie is the daughter of Lenore Bullock, and has taught alongside her Mother since the age of 14. Growing up, Melanie trained in RAD ballet, ISTD jazz and tap, and contemporary. During this time, she was lucky enough to perform at Disneyland, as a Kids Crew member for Coca Cola Christmas in the park and in numerous musical theatre productions. Although Melanie enjoyed performing, she made a decision very early on that teaching was her passion. She has worked most recently as a teacher, choreographer and adjudicator. At Studio 246, she is in charge of all the junior and intermediate troupes, and over 30 soloists. Her soloists have gained many top awards around NZ and Australia, and her troupes, continually bring home first places at competitions, including coveted overall awards. She was recently made a teaching member of Theatrical Dance International and also holds an honours degree in Speech and Language Therapy.

Melanie has a strong affinity with children and is combining her skills, with the view to implement an all inclusive dance programme for students who may find regular dance classes challenging. Melanie is very much looking forward to meeting the amazing dancers from the Invercargill area.
